Reception

In Reception this week we have been looking at the story 'Peace at Last' and talking about bedtime and the things that we can see and hear at night. The children have started to learn their first letter sounds in phonics and how to write each letter. We have been so impressed with the children's effort in their early writing.









KS1

In Key Stage One this week we have enjoyed many activities. In Science, we explored the importance of exercise. We all completed a Joe Wicks workout and talked about how we felt after exercise. Lots of us enjoyed the activity and felt happy! In RE we went on a nature scavenger hunt in the playground and wild area. In the coming weeks we will look at who Christian's believe made nature and our world and we will ask the question, 'Does God want Christians to look after our world?'. We also started our new PSHE scheme this week and we discussed who we can talk to if we have a worry or concern. The children thought of lots of trusted adults and family members. We were very impressed.









LKS2

This week in LKS2 we have been finding out all about Europe. In Geography lessons we started by recapping our previous learning by revising the continents. That was followed the next lesson with some work identifying the different countries of the continent. There are 46 in total – how many do you think you would be able to name? Once we had learnt more about the countries, we then looked at the capital cities. Did you know that the capital city of Luxembourg is Luxembourg City? We learnt more about these capitals by studying our class atlases whilst playing a game on the World Geography Games website. Our final sessions have been all about physical features found in Europe. We have looked at the key mountain ranges and rivers, learning which countries these are found in. Finally, we created our own book, using the Book Creator app on the ipads, to explain more about these geographical features.





UKS2

In DT, we have begun our work on 'seasonality'. There was no better to start our topic than visiting our school vegetable patch. Whilst there, we discussed what fruit and vegetables were in season and harvested what the school had grown. Look out for what we 'cook up' next!

In science, the circulatory system has been our topic. We have discussed the importance of the heart and have created our own representations. We are building on our LKS2 knowledge of the digestive system and how nutrients are absorbed into the blood and transported around the body.
